



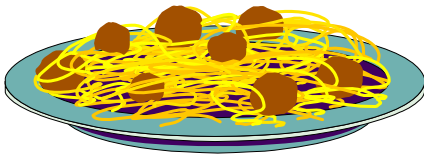

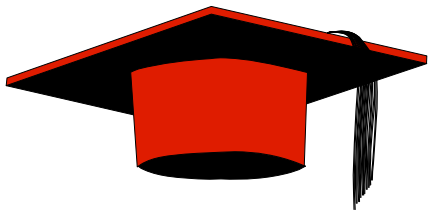
Family for the Holidays
